

# Crochet Cherry Pie

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## Abbreviations:

ch = chain  
SC = single crochet  
DC = double crochet  
HDC = half double crochet  
INC = increase  
DEC = decrease  
st = stitch  
sl st = slip stitch  
fo = fasten off  
\* = repeat for the row

## Materials:

Red Heart comfort yarn Tan (size 4)  
Bernat premium yarn in red (size 4)  
3 mm crochet hook  
Needle  
Scissors  
Polyester fiber-fill  
Cardboard circle (5cm / 2in diameter)



### • **Pie Shell (Tan yarn and 3mm hook):**

Note: The 1<sup>st</sup> chains of each row don't count as a stitch.

Make a magic ring.

Row 1: ch2 / 12 DC / 1sl st in the first dc of the row. Pull the beginning yarn to close the hole. (T=12 st)

Row 2: ch2 / 2 DC on each st =12inc / 1 DC in the base of the first ch2 / 1sl st in the first dc of the row (T=25 st)

Row 3: ch 2 / \*1 INC / 1 DC \* / 1 DC in the base of the first ch2 / 1sl st in the first dc of the row (T=39 st)

Row 4: ch2 / \* 1 INC / 2 DC \* / 1sl st in the first dc of row (T=52 st)

Row 5: ch2 / \* 1 INC / 3 DC \* / 1sl st in the first dc of row (T=65 st)

➤ Remove the hook from the yarn and insert the hook in the first st, back to front, and pull the yarn to the back of the work.

Row 6: ch1 / make 1 SC on each st, in the BACK LOOP ONLY / sl st (T=65 st)

Row 7: ch1 / 30 SC / 1 inc SC / 30 SC / 1 inc SC / 3SC / sl st. (T=67 st)

Row 8: ch1 / 15 SC / 1 inc SC / 30 SC / 1 inc SC / 20SC / sl st. (T=69 st)

Row 9: ch1 / 30 SC / 1 inc SC / 30 SC / 1 inc SC / 7SC / sl st. (T=71 st)

Row 10: ch1 / 1 reversed SC on each st / sl st. (T=71 st)

➤ Cut the yarn, fo and with the hook pull the tail to the inside of the work.

### • **Top (3mm hook and red yarn size 4):**

➤ Always place a marker in the first st of each row. The ch2 doesn't count as a st.

➤ Make a magic ring.

Row 1: ch2 / 12 DC / sl st. (T=12 st)

Row 2: ch2 / 1 inc DC on each st / 1 DC in the base to the first ch2 / sl st. (T=25 st)

Row 3: ch 2 / \*1 inc DC / 1 DC \* / 1 DC in the base to the first ch2 / sl st. (T=39 st)

Row 4: ch2 / \*1 inc DC / 2 DC \* / sl st. (T=52 st)

Row 5: ch2 / \*1 inc DC / 3 DC \* / sl st (T=65 st)

Row 6: ch 1 / 1 SC on each st / sl st.

(T=65 st)

- Make a sl st, cut the yarn and leave a long tail for sewing. Fo.
- The top is going to be smaller than the last row of the crust, it is supposed to be like that, because after stuffing the pie it will be more tight.
- Place the cardboard circle inside the pie.
- Sew the top and the bottom together. Half way through sewing, put the stuffing in and sew the rest. While sewing skip 5 random stitches from the base
- Hide the end of the yarn inside the pie, and cut off the excess.



- **Lattice** (3mm hook Tan yarn, size 4):

Make a magic ring and ch2 / 1 cluster st / close the magic ring / ch2 / on top of the previous cluster make another cluster. Make 8 cluster st in total.

**Cluster stitch:** Wrap the yarn around the hook, insert the hook in the base, pull the yarn through, wrap the yarn around the hook and pull through 2 loops, leaving 2 loops in the hook. Wrap the yarn, insert the hook in the base, pull the yarn through, wrap the yarn around the hook, and pull the yarn through 2 loops leaving 3 loops in the hook. Repeat one more time, leaving 4 loops in the hook. Wrap the yarn around the hook and pull through all 4 loops. Wrap the yarn around the hook and pull through the last loop.



- Make 2 cords with 8 clusters
- Make 4 cords with 6 clusters

- Sew the two 8 cluster cord first, making a cross with them in the middle.
- Sew the four 6 cluster, WEAVING them in a criss-cross pattern.



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
